CALIFORNIA PROPOSITION 65

WARNING

California's Proposition 65, also called the California State Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act, was enacted in 1986. As part of the law, the state is required to publish a list of chemicals that are "known to the State of California to cause cancer or reproductive toxicity." This list now contains over 900 chemicals. The complete list can be found on the California Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (OEHHA) website.

This warning means one or more listed chemicals may be present in its product. Kinetrol USA labels its shipments to California using a method approved by the State of California as follows:

Even though the materials used in all Kinetrol USA products conform to all California federal government regulations and product standards, California's Proposition 65 requires all businesses to provide a "clear and reasonable warning" if one or more listed chemicals may be present in the product, even if that chemical is present in trace quantities. In compliance with this law, a warning will appear on Kinetrol shipments to California.
